WHITE BUBBLES

A cheerful sparkling Chardonnay from the Loire Valley, with excellent freshness and just the right amount of bubbles to make this an easy-quaffing, party wine.

Fresh and cool, with pear, apple and lemon flavours. Their wines require no bolstering with oak, although lengthy 'lees' ageing adds creamy complexity.

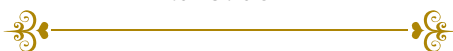
